IMPORTANT NOTES

- Candidates must complete the Cambridge application form BEFORE the entries closing date. Late entries might not be accepted and late entry fee applies. If you are under 18, it must be signed by a parent or guardian (your teacher cannot sign the form).
- If you require special arrangements for the test, you must inform us at least one week before the entries closing date to ensure that arrangements can be made with Cambridge Assessment English.
- Your exam timetable will be sent to the email address provided on the application form – please write this clearly in CAPITAL LETTERS
- Write your name on your application form EXACTLY how you would like it to appear on your result
- You must provide a copy of your VALID PHOTOGRAPHIC ID (passport or EEA card). You must bring the same ID with you on test day
- No refunds are made if you cannot attend the test. Please contact BSC if you are unable to attend the test for medical or compassionate reasons.
- Ensure that you read the summary of regulations before test day
- 3-4 weeks after results are released online, your certificate will be delivered to BSC. We will then post it to the address provided on test day. Use the information on your Confirmation of Entry to access your results online.
- If you experience any problems on test day, you must report them to an invigilator before the end of the test day.

What to bring on test day

- Pen (blue or black ink)
- Pencil
- Eraser/rubber
- Sharpener
- ID (the same ID that was used on application)
- Still water in a clear plastic bottle with the label removed

Highlighters are permitted in the test room but must NOT be used on answer sheets. Tissues are provided in test rooms (if needed).

Watches are not permitted inside the test room.

All electronic items must be completely switched off and handed in at registration. You cannot use electronic items until the end of the test.
